Dr. Kit Grauer is professor Emerita of Art and Museum Education at the University of British Columbia. Kit is actively involved in art education organizations at the local, national, and international levels. Although retired, she continues to pursue her research interests in artistic strategies in education, museum education, and community-based new media education.

Kit is Chair of the Gulf of Georgia Historic Cannery Society and holds a research grant looking at digital media and youth art makers. She has presented art-making sessions in conferences all across Canada, the United States, China, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Europe, and South America. Since retiring from UBC, Kit and her husband, Peter Scurr, are actively involved leading workshops at their studio on Galiano Island for Elder College, numerous school and service groups and an international printmaking collective.
